THE POSITION

Under the direction of the Operations Manager, this entry-level position will perform a variety of semi-skilled and skilled tasks in the maintenance and repair of District facilities, parks, buildings, sports fields, and equipment. The position may be assigned to work split shifts, evenings, early mornings, weekends and holidays, as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of: General use of hand tools and safe working practices. Skill in: Use in hand tools in unskilled construction and repair; observe safety in the work environment; understand simple oral and written directions; maintain effective working relationships with co-workers; and perform heavy manual labor; carry out written and oral instructions without close supervision; and establish and maintain cooperative relationships with persons contacted in the course of work.

Possession of, or ability to obtain, a current valid California Driver's License.
